apokalypsis

(feminine noun) an uncovering; made bare or naked; a revelation, to be revealed; an unveiling of truth previously unknown



Revelation 1:1-2

This is the **revelation** of Jesus Christ, which God gave him to show to his servants the things which must happen soon, which he sent and made known by his angel to his servant, John, who testified to God's word and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, about everything that he saw.

Context is key!

We need to look at the book of Revelation in the context of the entire Biblical narrative

A Cosmic War Being Played Out

Genesis 1-2: God's original design—And it was *very good*...

Genesis 3: The Cosmic War begins

Genesis 12: God initiates—I will bless all nations through you...

Exodus: The One True God makes Himself known

Rest of OT: Israel fails to be a blessing to all nations

Gospels: The Kingdom has arrived—Already... Not yet (G.E. Ladd)

Acts to the end of the Age: The gospel must be preached to all nations...

Revelation 1-20: Repent for the end (of the Cosmic War) is at hand...

Revelation 21-22: Restoration of God's original design

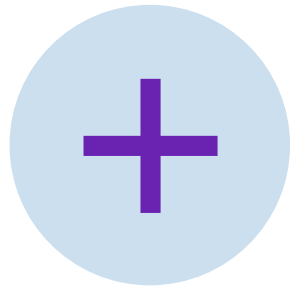

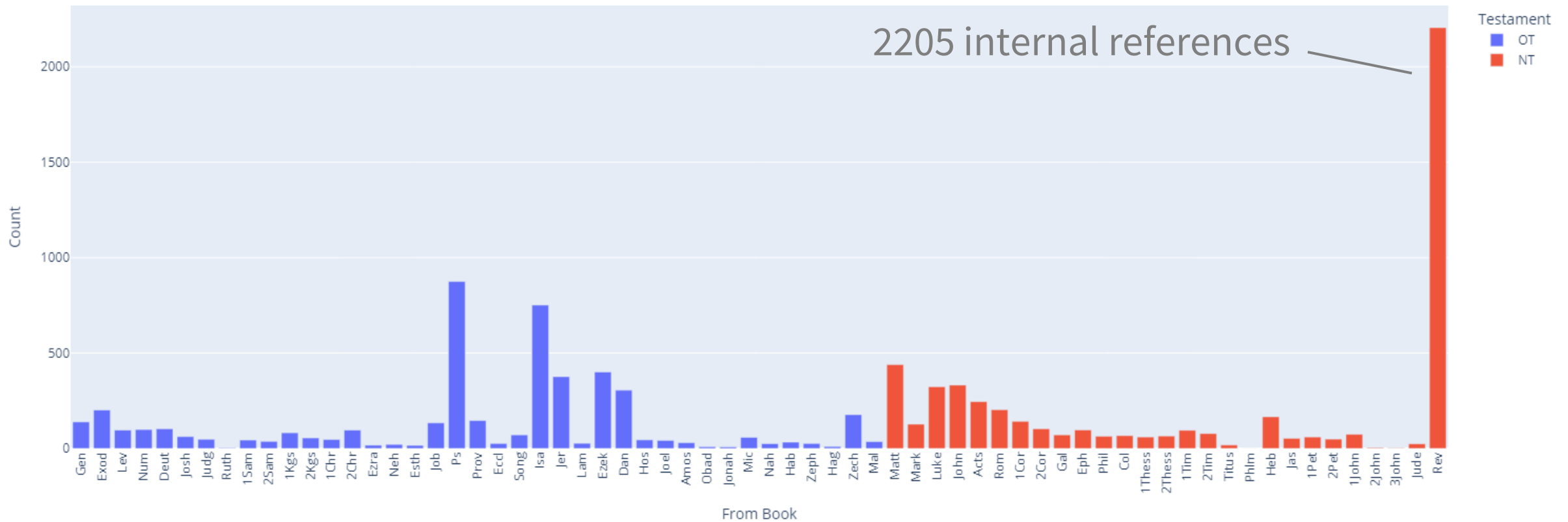

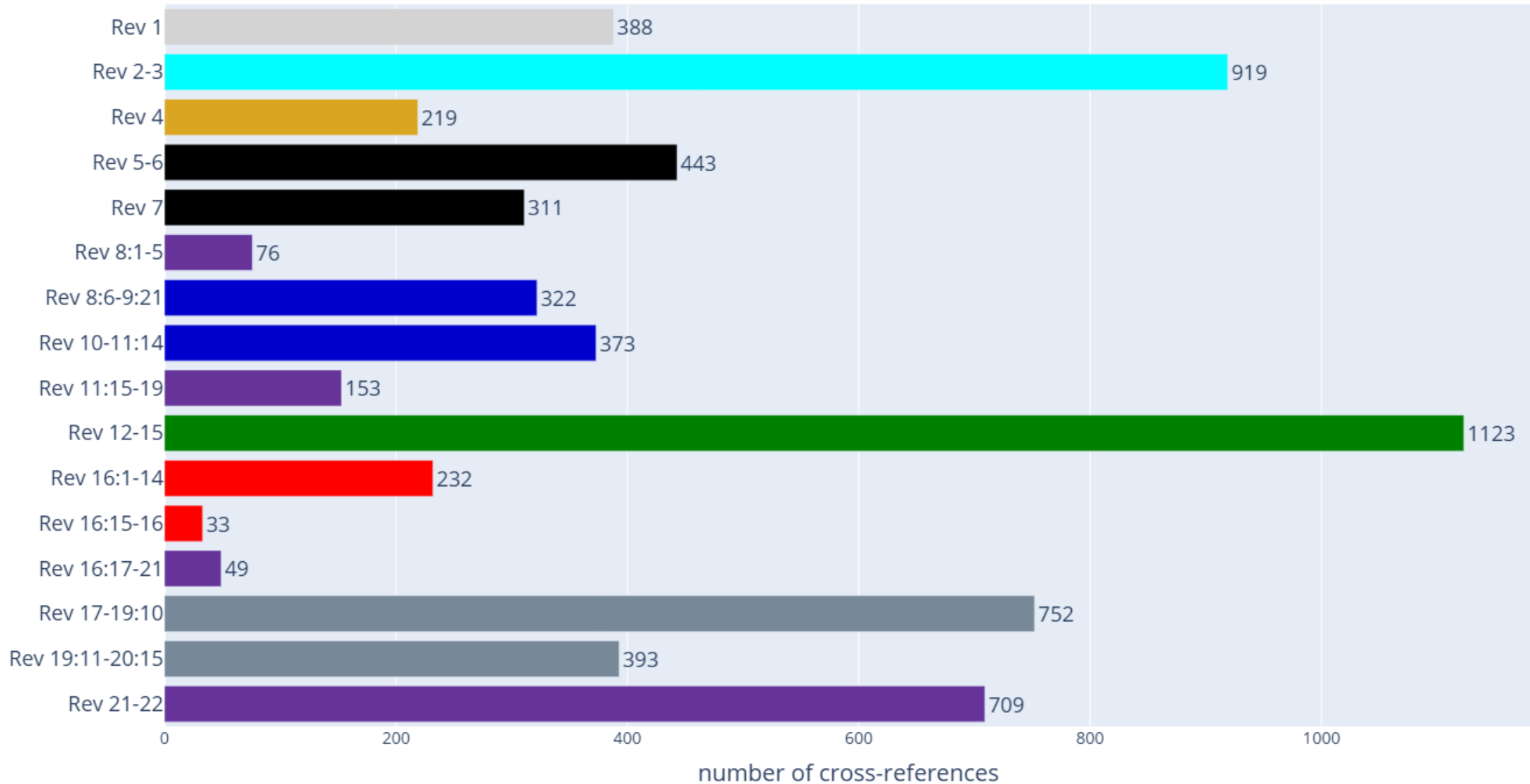

The Millennium: Symbolic or Literal?



1000

- 1000 years is $10 \times 10 \times 10$
- 10 is symbolic of completeness
 - 3 is symbolic of God



1000 could mean the millennial reign is *complete* in God's timing

Three views of the Millennium

1000

Premillennial:

- Christ returns before a literal millennial reign on Earth
- Satan's binding is a literal physical restriction as described in the text



Postmillennial:

- Christ returns after a future golden age of increasing Christian influence
- Satan is progressively restricted by the increasing influence of the Gospel



Amillennial:

- Symbolic millennium is the current age; Christ reigns from Heaven
- Satan's binding is a spiritual restriction imposed by God

Interpretation Frameworks

1. **Preterist.** Events described here were largely fulfilled in the first century AD.
2. **Historicist.** Events have and continue to unfold in history until Kingdom culmination.
3. **Futurist.** Most events described here have yet to occur, especially Chapters 4-22.
4. **Idealist.** Events are symbolic and allegorical about the ongoing conflict between good & evil.
5. **Composite.** Integrates and interweaves multiple framework views together.

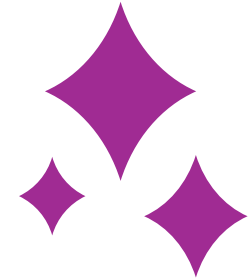

Idealist

Complete loss of any historical and prophetic value

A better approach? Composite Framework

Affirming elements in all four frameworks that better harmonize and reconcile passages in Revelation with other passages in the Bible.

A Composite Lens

Preterist

Some events have already occurred in the past, e.g., particularly the first and fourth “Sevens”

Historicist

God does indeed work in and throughout history and we can and should expect some events to actually occur

Futurist

Many events appear to not have occurred yet, e.g., Great Multitude, Final Judgment, New Heaven & Earth, etc.

Idealist

Much of the text is poetic and symbolic, attempting to describe fantastical and disturbing visions

Interpretation Frameworks

1. **Preterist.** Events described here were largely fulfilled in the first century AD.
2. **Historicist.** Events have and continue to unfold in history until Kingdom culmination.
3. **Futurist.** Most events described here have yet to occur, especially Chapters 4-22.
4. **Idealist.** Events are symbolic and allegorical about the ongoing conflict between good & evil.
5. **Composite.** Integrates and interweaves multiple framework views together.

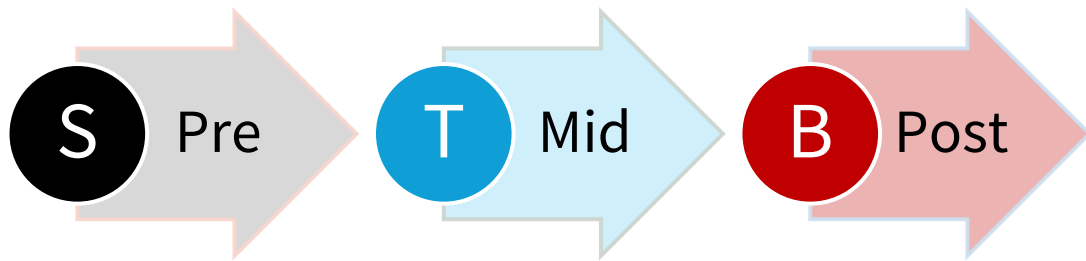

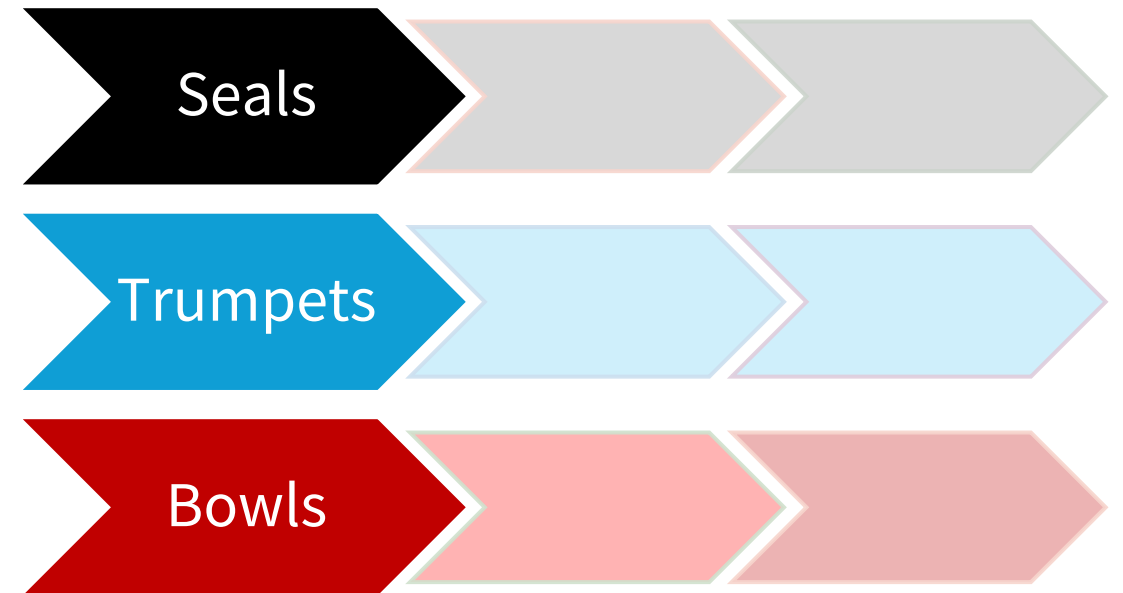

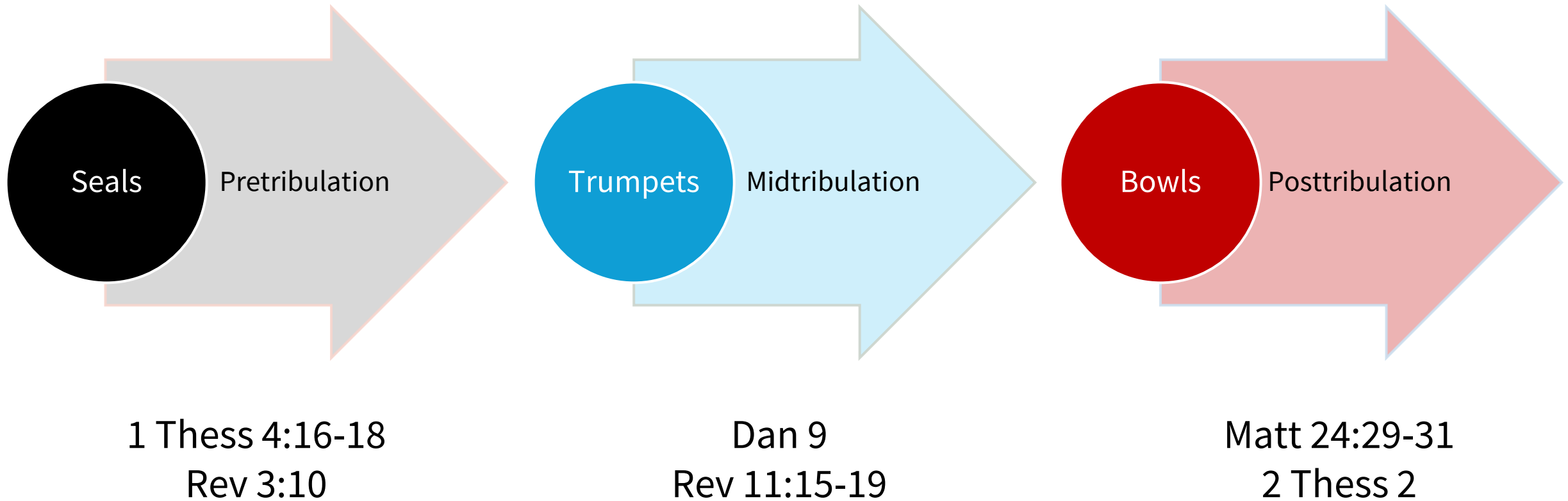

(chronological)



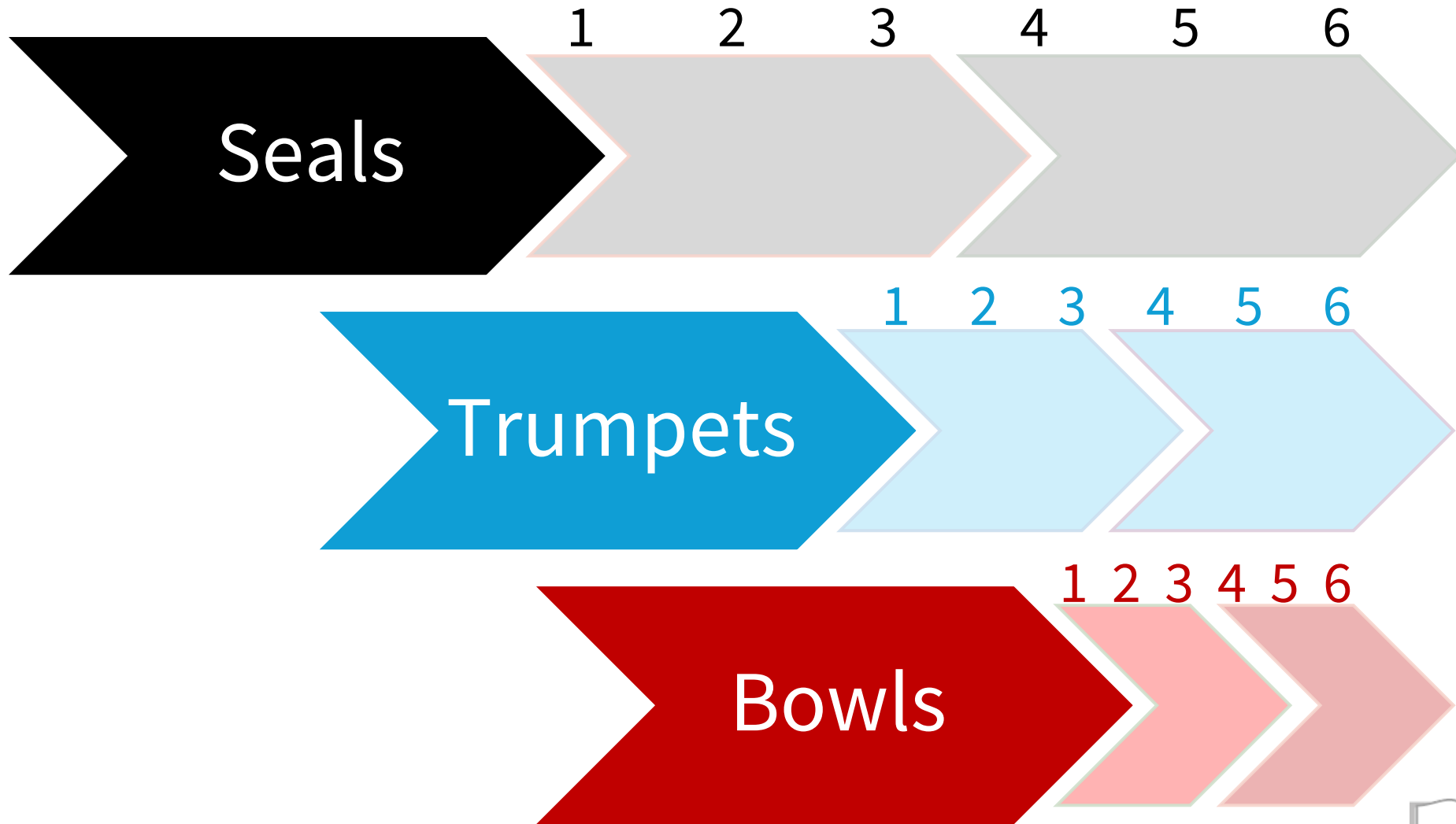
Events occur in parallel

There was a rainbow around the throne, like an emerald to look at. ⁴ Around the throne were *twenty-four* thrones. On the thrones were *twenty-four* elders sitting, dressed in *white garments*, with *crowns of gold* on their heads. ⁵ **Out of the throne proceed lightnings, sounds, and thunders.** There were *seven lamps* of fire burning before his throne, which are the *seven Spirits of God*. ⁶ Before the **throne** was something like a *sea of glass*, similar to crystal. In the middle of the **throne**, and around the **throne** were *four living creatures full of eyes* before and behind.




Center of the Chiastic Structure

The Prostitute (the Unfaithful)

¹ One of the seven angels who had the **seven bowls** came and spoke with me, saying, “Come here. I will show you the judgment of the great prostitute who sits on many waters, ² with whom the kings of the earth committed sexual immorality. Those who dwell in the earth were made drunken with the wine of her sexual immorality.”

Resonance: **Woe, Woe**

⁹⁻¹⁰ The **kings** of the earth who committed sexual immorality and lived wantonly with her will weep and wail over her..., saying, '**Woe, woe**, the great city, Babylon, the strong city! For your judgment has come in one hour.'

¹⁵ The **merchants** of these things, who were made rich by her, will stand far away for the fear of her torment, weeping and mourning, ¹⁶ saying, '**Woe, woe**, the great city, she who was dressed in fine linen, purple, and scarlet, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls!

¹⁷ Every **ship master, sailors, and mariners**, and as many as gain their living by sea, stood far away, ¹⁸ and cried out as they looked at the smoke of her burning, saying..., '**Woe, woe**, the great city, in which all who had their ships in the sea were made rich by reason of her great wealth!' ¹ After these things I heard something like a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, “**Hallelujah! Salvation, power, and glory belong to our God;**” ² for his judgments are true and righteous. For he has judged the great prostitute who corrupted the earth with her sexual immorality, and he has avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.” ³ A second said, “**Hallelujah!** Her smoke goes up forever and ever.” ⁴ The **twenty-four elders and the four living creatures** fell down and worshiped God who sits on the throne, saying, “**Amen! Hallelujah!**” ⁵ A voice came from the throne, saying, “Give praise to our God, all you his servants, you who fear him, the small and the great!”

The Bride of the Lamb (the Faithful)

⁶ I heard something like the voice of a great multitude, and like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of mighty thunders, saying, “**Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns!**” ⁷ Let’s rejoice and be exceedingly glad, and let’s give the glory to him. **For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his wife has made herself ready.**” ⁸ It was given to her that she would array herself in bright, pure, fine linen, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.

⁹ He said to me, “Write, ‘Blessed are those who are invited to the **wedding supper** of the **Lamb.**’ ” He said to me, “These are true words of God.” ¹⁰ I fell down before his feet to worship him.
